



ASSESSMENT MODE

Keep students focused during digital assessments — zero tab-switching, zero off-task browsing.

Assessment Mode is a classroom control feature that helps teachers launch quizzes, tests, LMS activities, and web-based assignments to every student device instantly — while automatically keeping students within teacher-approved content.

Once launched, the Assessment Mode places students in a **controlled, fully locked-down session** that keeps them on the assigned content and prevents off-task browsing. This:

- supports academic integrity
- keeps students on task, and
- helps ensure everyone completes assessments under the same focused conditions.



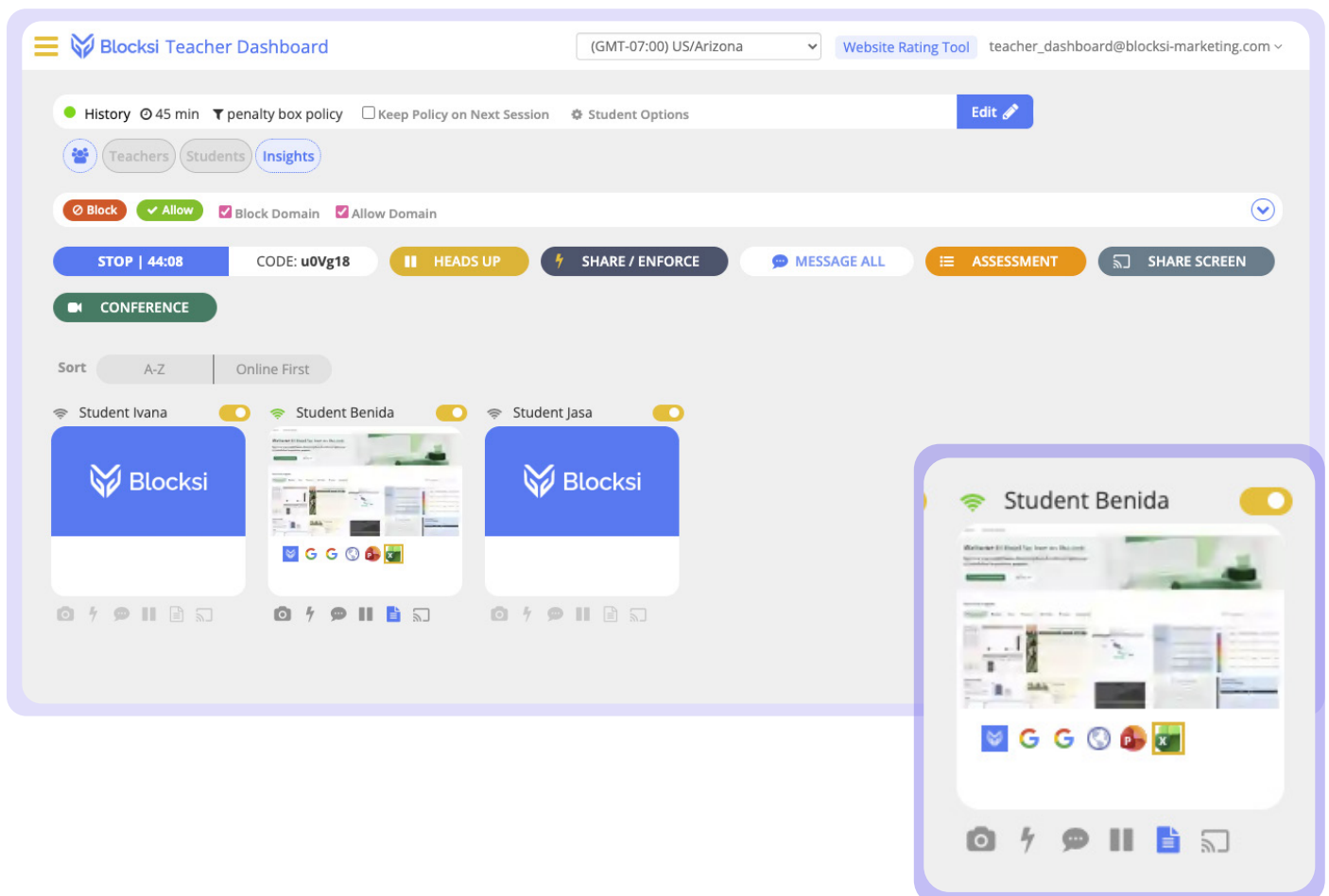
Blocksi Assessment Mode lets teachers lock things down and choose exactly what students can access — with just a few clicks and minimal setup — all from the Teacher Dashboard, without extra tools or add-ons.

Unlike many similar tools, Blocksi lets you allow full domains with simple wildcards and adjust rules mid-assessment — so you don't have to rebuild everything from scratch every time.

Assessment Mode turns your classroom into a locked-down testing environment in seconds, keeping every student on the right content with minimal setup.

With one action, teachers can:

- Push a quiz, LMS, or web app to students
- Close all unrelated tabs automatically
- Allow only specific pages or entire websites
- Prevent off-task browsing
- Adjust access in real time, while the assessment is running



How it works:

1. Prepare the assessment

Use an LMS, a web app, pick between existing presets, or insert your own links.

2. Control access

Enforced URLs = must-open pages

Allowed URLs = additional resources

Use wildcards to allow full domains

3. Push to students

All open tabs close automatically

Correct content opens instantly

4. Stay flexible

Add new URLs mid-assessment

Adjust settings for a group or a single student

Stop assessment anytime — previously opened tabs restore instantly

Pick between "Assessment" and "Web Apps" modes

Assessment	Web Apps
Page-level control. Ideal for tests, quizzes, and strict focus.	Whole-site access. Ideal for LMS, assignments, interactive tools. Pick from a library of popular teacher apps.
Example: Lock students into a single Google Form or Testportal quiz, with only approved reference links available.	Example: Open Google Classroom or Nearpod so students can navigate lessons, resources, and activities freely within that platform.

- Instantly get everyone on the right assignment
- Lock students into a test environment (no sneaky tabs or workarounds)
- Launch LMS tasks without confusion
- Reduce “Where do I go?” interruptions
- Run controlled assessments using the tool you already use — with presets and wildcards that save setup time every single class
